Inside Out: Joy

As we finish our series with the emotion of *joy*, I would invite you to read all of Philippians this week. Philippians expresses joy for living in relationship with Jesus. For today, read Philippians 1:1-30

Philippians 1:1-11

- What can you learn about Paul from these verses?
- Why did the Philippians bring Paul joy?
- Who is someone of whom you can say, "I thank my God every time I think of you" (v.3), and why?
- Paul was grateful for their partnership in ministry of the gospel (v. 5). How would you define "the gospel"? Do you believe the gospel changes people? Has the gospel changed your life?
- Paul has specific hopes he is praying for the Philippians (v. 9-11). Why do you think these specific things are important for Paul to be praying for?

Philippians 1:12-30

- Consider a time when you (or a loved one) experienced hardship or suffering. How did you respond to that situation?
- How would you describe Paul's mood and response to being imprisoned? What enables Paul to see things as he does?
- What all do you think is meant by "to love is Christ and to die is gain" (v. 21)?
- Paul feels confident that God has more work for him to do (vv.23-25), even though he admits that his first desire is to be with God. How can his attitude here serve as a model for you in times of suffering, challenge and waiting?
- What does a life look like that is "worthy of the gospel of Christ" (v. 27)?
