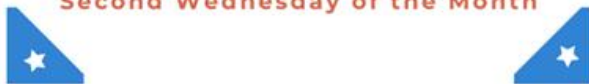

interests, please contact Deidre at dimthurn@sharingtheheart.org to let us know.

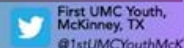
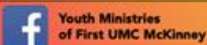
