Sermon: Love-filled Grace Scripture: John 8:2-11

Sermon Notes

- 1. Read John 8:2-11.
- 2. Have you ever done something wrong (sinned) and felt guilt or shame?
- 3. FYI Guilt and shame are different. Guilt is when you feel bad for doing something specific. Shame is feeling that you are a bad person overall and unworthy or inadequate.
- 4. How has guilt/shame had a negative impact on your life?
- 5. In the scripture reading everyone is changed by encountering Jesus the legal experts and Pharisees see the error of their judgment and drop their stones and leave, and the woman receives forgiveness and redemption. In what ways have you been changed by encountering Jesus?
- 6. Jesus wants everyone to know the unconditional love and redemption of God that is realized through God's forgiveness. What areas of your life need forgiving?
- 7. Spend time in prayer asking Jesus to forgive your sin and know the love of Jesus is greater than any sin, guilt or shame you may be dealing with.

8.	Know that through Christ you are forgiven and you are loved!
