Sermon: Am I Playing Offense or Defense? Scripture: 1 Samuel 17:1-51

Sermon Notes

Take time this week to dig deeper into the message with these questions:

- I. Read 1 Samuel 17:1-51 and imagine what it would be like to be David.
- 2. What might it been like to be the youngest brother and physically the smallest brother?
- 3. How would you feel knowing your brothers were soldiers while you were a shepherd?
- 4. What would be your first thoughts when you saw Goliath taunting the Israelite army and how terrified they were of him (verses 8-11)?
- 5. What was David's reaction to seeing Goliath (verse 26)?
- 6. Why was David's reaction so different than the other Israelites?
- 7. Consider the "Goliaths" (those things that hinder, hurt, or get in the way of you fully experiencing the love of God) you have in your life...broken relationships, debt, addiction, unforgiveness, pride, prejudice, anger, greed, etc.
- 8. For each "Goliath" consider how you could defeat it with God's help...prayer, scripture, trust, accountability partner, etc.

9.	Spend time in prayer seeking God's help, trusting in the power of Christ, and standing faithful in front of your Goliaths
