

Sermon: Faith Legacy Scripture: Acts 2:1-21

Sermon Notes

Take time this week to dig deeper into the message with these questions:

- 1. Imagine having the perfect birthday party. Where would it be, what would you do, who would be there, what gifts would you hope to receive?
- 2. Pentecost, which means "fiftieth," occurs 50 days after Easter and celebrates the Holy Spirit descending upon and empowering hundreds if not thousands of people to share the Good News of Jesus. It is considered the moment when the Christian church truly began. It is the church's birthday!
- 3. Read the story of Pentecost in Acts 2:1-21.
- 4. Those at the "party" received the gift of the Holy Spirit. Since then, anyone who accepts Jesus as Lord and Savior receives the gift of Holy Spirit. If you are a Christian what gifts have your received from God, Christ, and the Holy Spirit?
- 5. In what ways is God calling you to share your gifts and blessings with others?
- 6. Who do you know that needs to be invited to God's party...a loving relationship with Jesus?
- 7. Spend time in prayer giving thanks for God's love and the blessings you have received, and for opportunities to share the love of Christ with others.
