Scripture: Acts 16:23-34

Sermon Notes

During the *At the Movies* series take time each week to read over the Scripture and ask these questions to see how they might shape your life.

1. What did you like most about this week's movie?
2. Who was the hero in this week's movie? What made them a hero?
3. Where do you see Christian messages (love, joy, forgiveness, patience, etc.) played out in this week's movie?
4. Read the week's scripture.
5. What do you think is the key message or teaching of this scripture?
6. If your life were turned into a movie, how would you want the biblical teaching to be played out on the big screen? How is God's truth being played out in your life today or what could you do to make it a reality?
7. How are you being a faith hero in the life another?
8. Who needs to hear about the faith growth you are experiencing through *At the Movies*? Go ahead and invite them to church to enjoy the popcorn, movie clips, and inspiring worship.
9. Spend time in prayer.
