# Sermon Notes

- 2. In the Bible, read Luke 10:25-37.
- 3. In verse 36, Jesus asks, "Which one of these three was a neighbor to the man who encountered thieves?" What was the legal expert's response?
- 4. Reread verses 34-35. What are the characteristics of one who is a good "neighbor?"
- 5. Considering these characteristics, what kind of "neighbor" are you to those in need?
- 6. Who do you know that could use some "neighborly" love? What will you do this week to show someone in need the love of Christ?
- 7. Spend time in prayer.
