Luke 1:26-38

Sermon: Love Scripture: Luke 1:26–38

Sermon Notes

- 1. In the Bible, read Luke 1:26-38.
- 2. This passage chronicles some amazing events. What words and phrases give you an idea of what this experience was like for Mary?
- 3. The angel referred to Mary as "favored" by God. Sit with the word "favored" for a moment. What would it be like to hear God call you "favored?"
- 4. What specific information does the angel Gabriel give to Mary about the son she would bear (vv.31-33, 35)?
- 5. Mary responds to the angel's declaration by asking how the promise would be fulfilled (v. 34). Do you think Mary's question was an expression of doubt? Why or why not?
- 6. What do you think would have been your response to a call from God for such a sacrifice on your part?
- 7. Are there places in your life that God is calling you to more? If so, what obstacles may be getting in the way? In what ways are you trusting God in these areas?
- 8. Spend time in prayer.
