




Dot to Dot – Puzzle and Coloring Page

The writer of Psalm 150 encourages everyone to praise God through music. Connect the dots to see how this person praises God through music.




Song of Praise – Song Writing Activity


Psalm 150:6 - Meditative Coloring Activity
