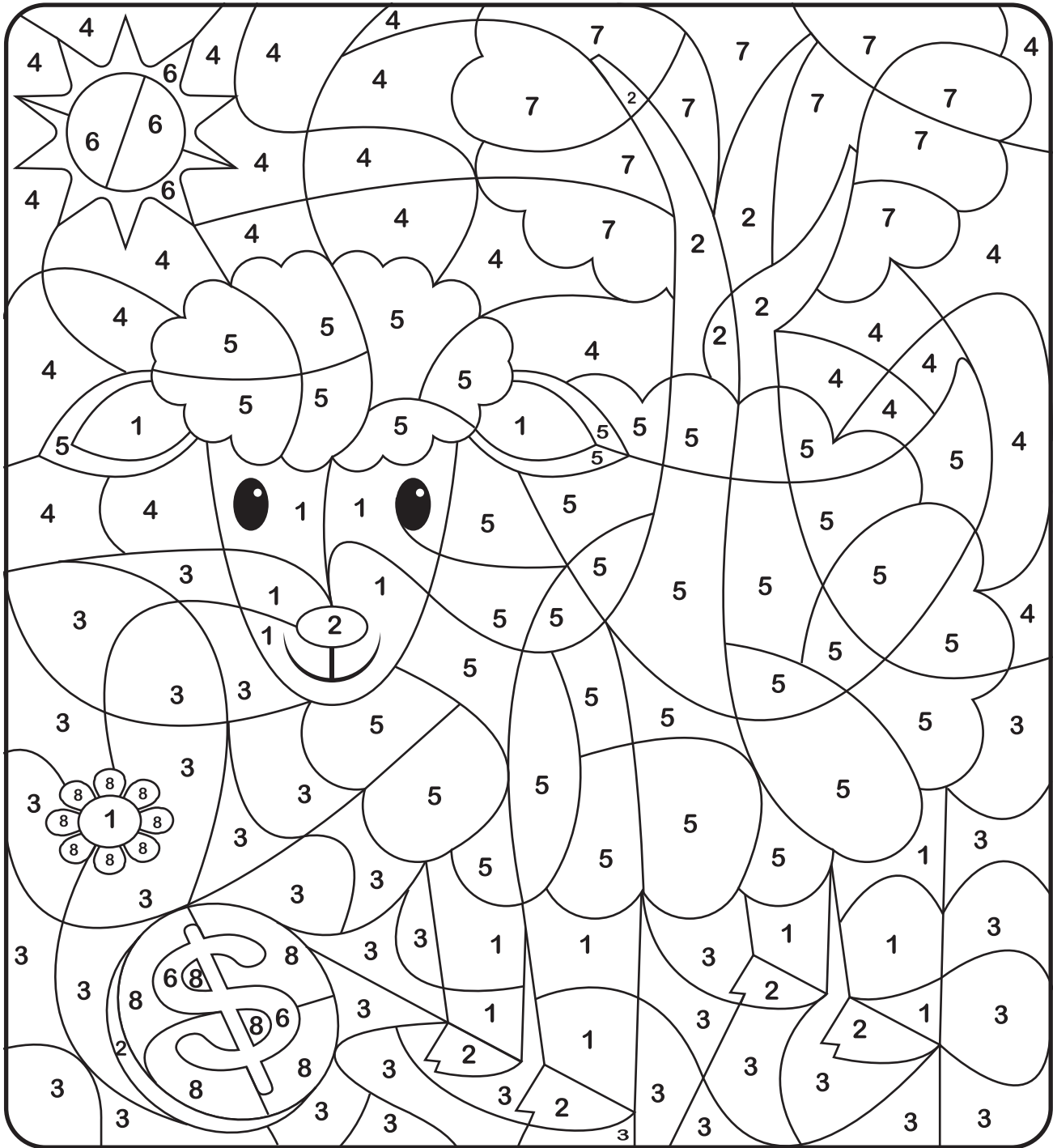

## The Lost Sheep and the Lost Coin – Luke 15:3-10
