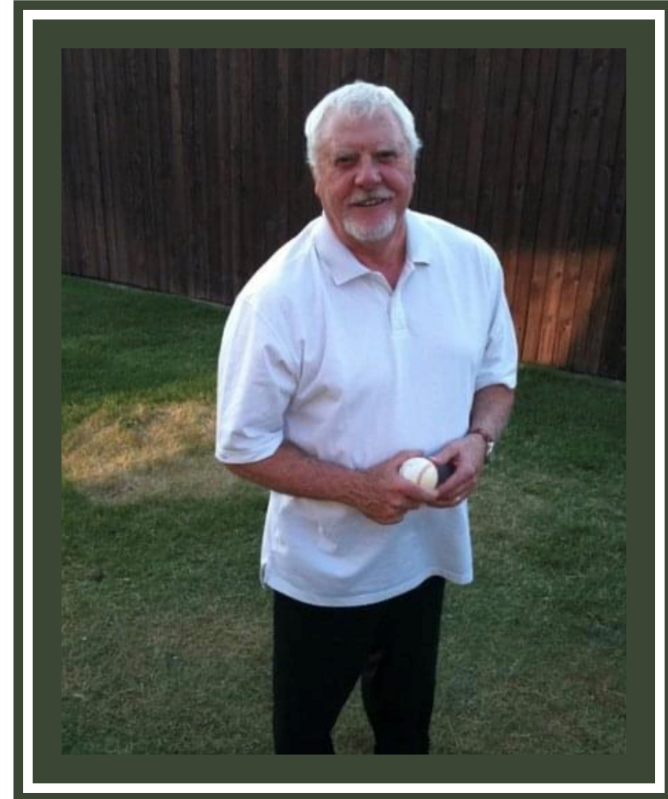

OBITUARY

Clifford Clement Carty, Jr. passed away on May 2, 2023, at his home in McKinney at the age of 84. He loved watching all sports; and playing golf with his "Buddies" was such a joy to him. His favorite pastime was cheering on his Grandkids at whatever sport they played.

Cliff was born to Clifford C. Carty, Sr. and Ethel Christine Carty on January 17, 1939, in Norristown, PA. After graduating from High School in 1956, he enlisted in the Service, and he wore his uniform proudly as a United States Marine. His assigned duty was to work as a helicopter mechanic.

He was married in 1960 to Lucille Romania, and soon became the proud Dad of James Patrick, Linda Lou, and Tina Marie. He joined the Police Force in Pottstown, PA, and said many times that it was the best job he ever had.

Years later, after moving to Texas, he met and married Susan Lea Hopkins on September 28, 1973, and he became a proud Dad once again to Chad Clayton in 1975.

Cliff started a Cotton Transportation Company in 1977, and he turned it into a successful business that lasted for over 30 years.
