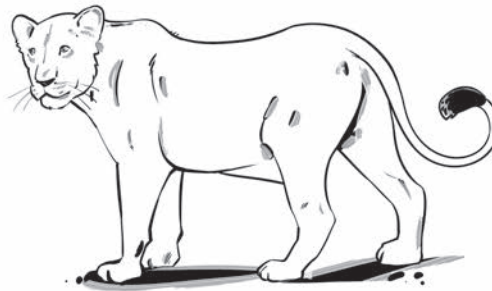
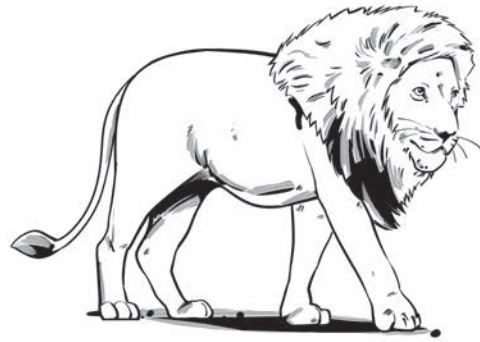
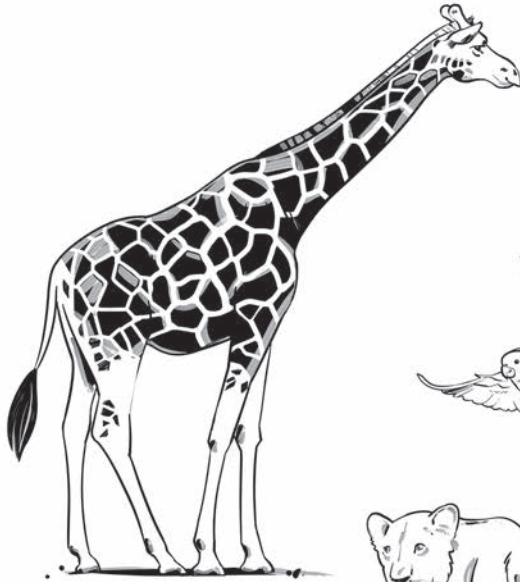

## Two by Two – Matching

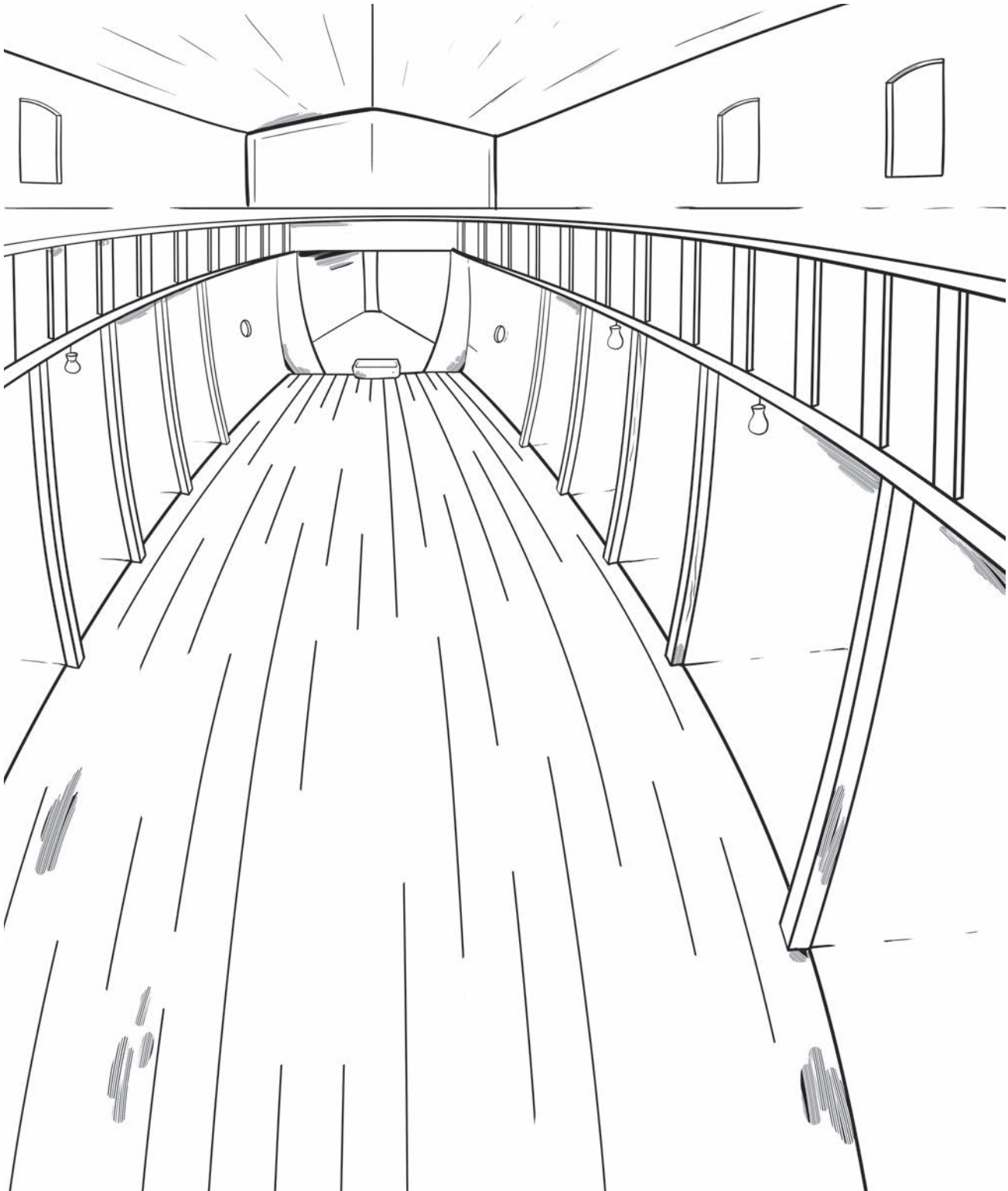
God told Noah to bring every kind of animal into the ark. What animals do you see?

Draw what you think the inside of Noah's ark looked like.

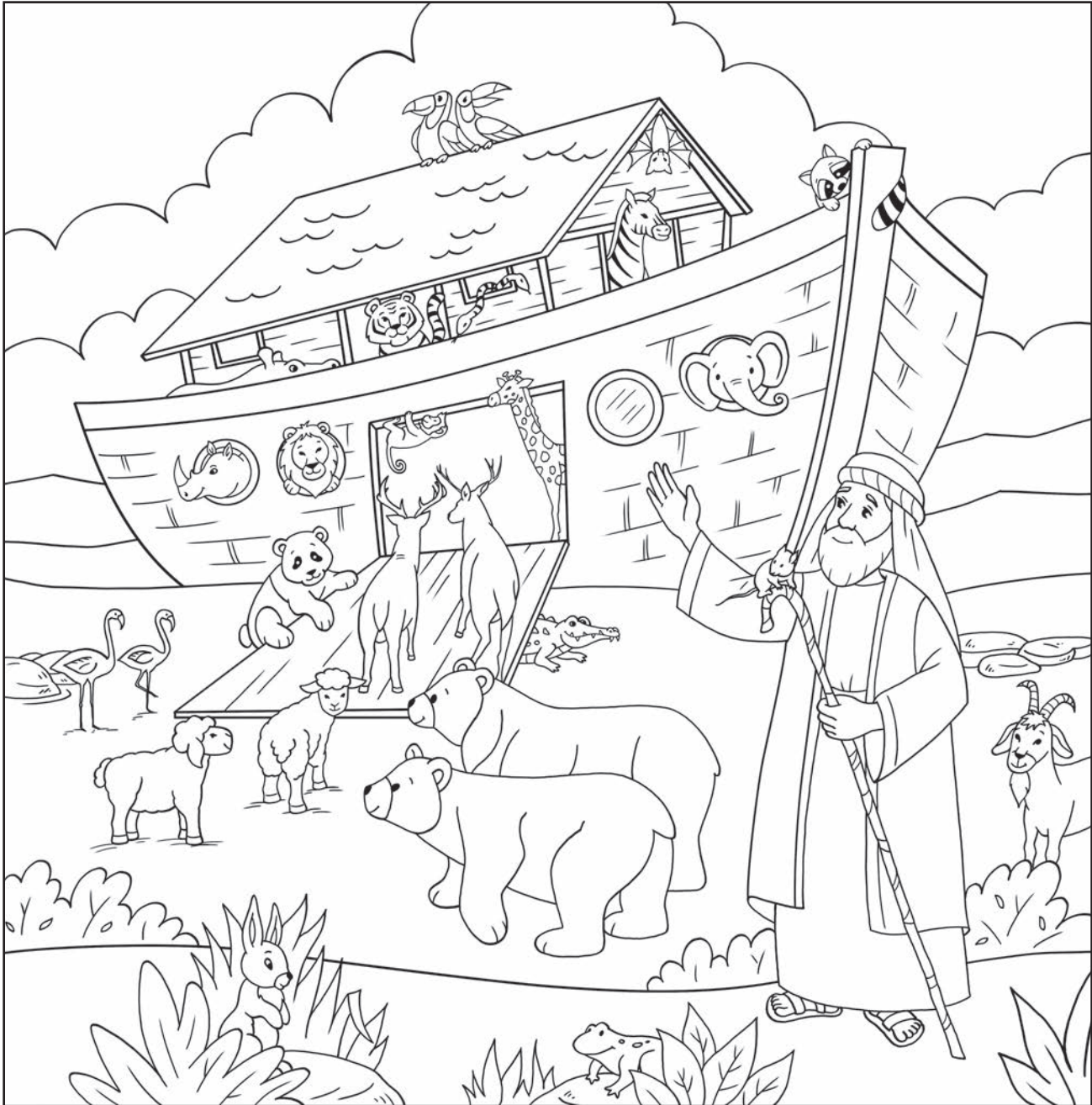

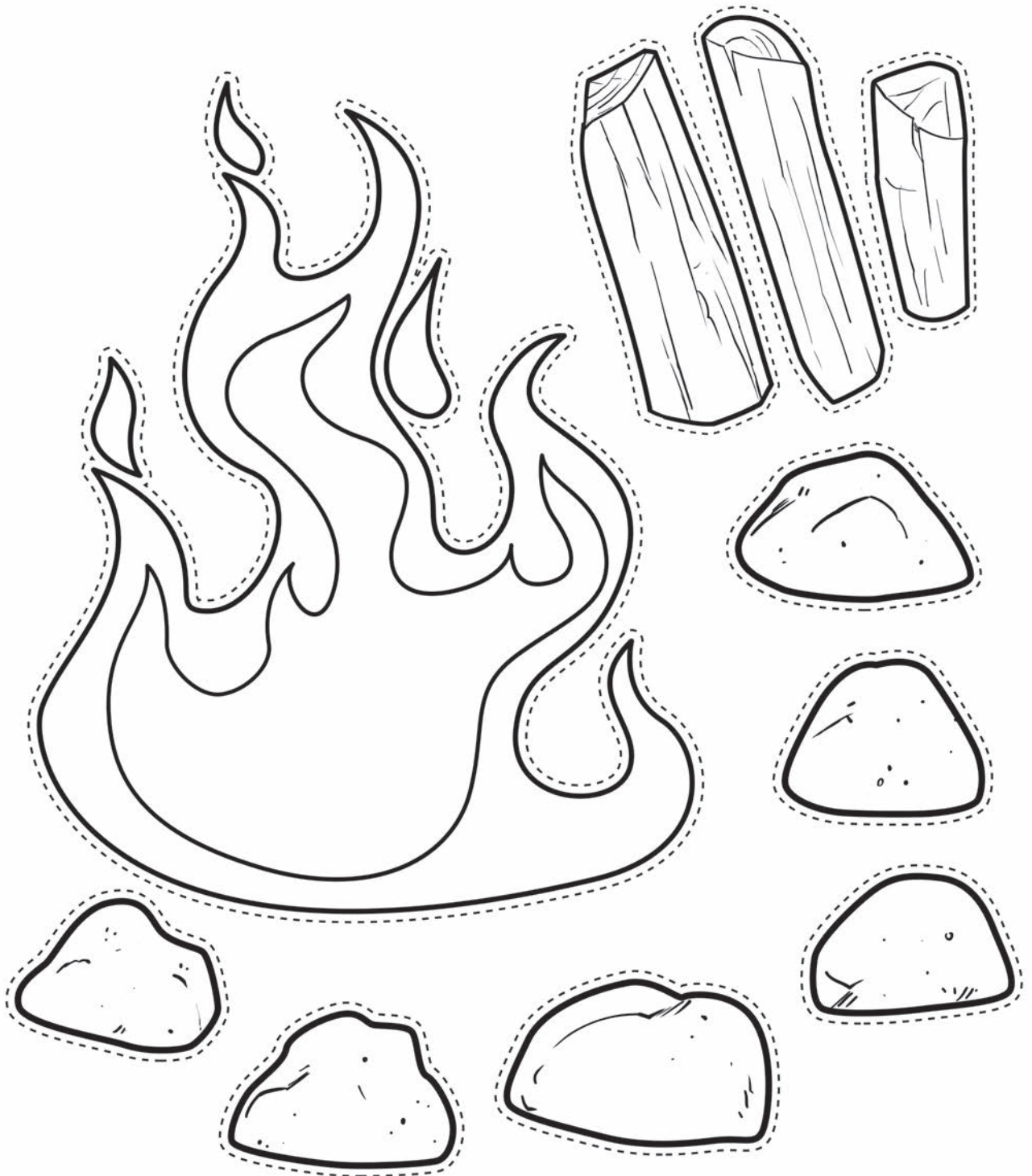

## Oral Tradition – At-Home Activity

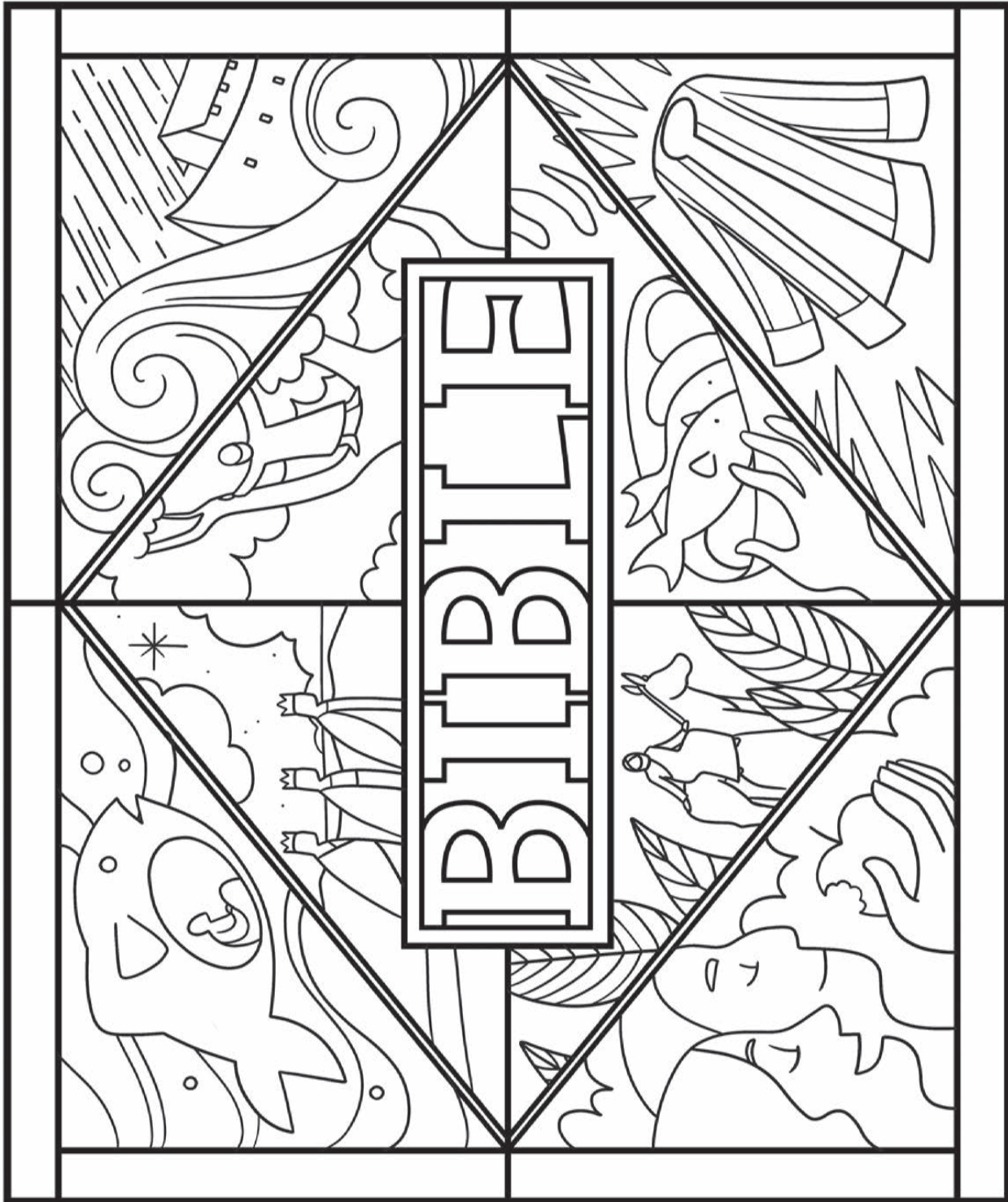
Cut out and color the campfire pieces. Assemble the pieces to look like a fire. Gather as a family and place the fire in the middle. Have each person share a favorite family story.
