
4A **Garden of Eden** – Coloring Page

4C My Church Cares – Activity


Use the following page to explore your church and look for ways your community is caring for the earth.

4D **Paper Helper Chain** – Craft


Use the template below to create a paper chain of helpers. (Instructions can be found on p. 41 of the Leader Guide.) On each paper person, write or draw someone who helps you.
